SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete an Ozarka College application for admission and admission requirements or be a current Ozarka student.
- Fill out a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form.
- Submit this scholarship application to the Ozarka College Admissions Office.
- Fulfill any additional criteria or requirements of the particular scholarship for which you are applying.

Deadline for Scholarships is March 1st unless specified.

Ozarka offers various kinds of scholarship assistance, including tuition waivers for spouses and children of employees and trustees, sponsored scholarships donated by area businesses and civic organizations (Lions Club, Kiwanis, Farm Bureau, VFW Ladies Auxiliary, etc.), and special designated scholarship programs (*all scholarships are on a funds available basis*).

Students who are eligible for multiple scholarships from Ozarka (Ozarka Academic Excellence, Ozarka Ambassador of the Year, Ozarka Regional Scholarship, PBL Leadership Scholarship, etc.) will be awarded only one of these, so the maximum number of students in the region will have access to higher education with no burden of tuition. Scholarships awarded by the state of Arkansas, civic clubs, area businesses, etc., are not subject to this provision. Academic Excellence Scholarship	Arkansas High School Seniors who plan to enroll as first-time, full time students within one year of graduation. Must score 24 composite on ACT or be in top 10% of class with a 3.0 GPA.	Fulfill scholarship requirements listed on front page of Scholarship Packet, submit ACT scores, official high school transcript, or a letter from high school counselor stating class rank and GPA.	Tuition scholarship, up to four consecutive semesters. Must maintain a 3.25 cumulative GPA and complete 12 hours per semester. Developmental courses not included.
English Department Scholarship	Awarded to two high school seniors who participate in the department's annual writing contest.	Compete in writing competition. Contact Ozarka College English department for contest rules.	Tuition scholarship, up to two consecutive semesters. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and complete 12 credit hours to remain eligible for second semester. Developmental courses not included.
FNBC Scholarship	Students residing in FNBC service area and enrolled full time at Ozarka College.	Fulfill scholarship requirements listed on front page of Scholarship Packet.	\$1,000 per semester, up to four semesters. Must maintain 2.75 GPA and complete 12 hours per semester.
John E. Miller Scholarship	Any student enrolled full-time and in good standing at Ozarka College.	Fulfill scholarship requirements listed on front page of Scholarship Packet. Write a one page biographical essay.	\$500 per semester, renewable for one semester by maintaining a 3.0 GPA.
New Horizon Scholarship	Applicants enrolling as first-time, full-time students after earning a GED with a score of at least 600. Applicants must have completed the GED within five years preceding enrollment.	Fulfill scholarship requirements listed on front page of Scholarship Packet, along with an official copy of GED score report.	Tuition scholarship, up to four consecutive semesters. Must maintain a 3.25 cumulative GPA and complete 12 hours per semester. Developmental courses not included.
Ozarka Regional Scholarship	All public high schools in Fulton, Izard, Sharp, and Stone counties, along with some other public high schools in the region, are provided with a scholarship to be rewarded annually to a graduating senior who wishes to attend Ozarka as a first-time, full-time student.	A committee named by each high school selects the recipient. To qualify, students must have a high school GPA of 2.50 or better on a 4.00 scale. You will need to express an interest to your high school counselor to be considered for this scholarship.	Tuition scholarship, up to four consecutive semesters. Must maintain a 2.25 cumulative GPA and complete 12 hours per semester. Developmental courses not included.
Izard County Farm Bureau	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be a member (either student or parent) of Izard County Farm Bureau. 2. Not qualified for full-time Pell or WIA 3. Show financial need 4. Meet minimum program standards with regard to Asset, Compass or ACT scores. 	Fulfill scholarship requirements listed on front page of Scholarship Packet. Write a short paragraph explaining your career objectives in your own handwriting	\$250 per semester, renewable for one semester by maintaining a 2.0 GPA and completing 12 credit hours.
Workforce Improvement Grant	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students age 24 or above 2. Arkansas & U.S. Resident 3. Must have unmet financial need according to federal methodology. 	Fulfill scholarship requirements listed on front page of Scholarship Packet.	Cost of tuition and fees up to \$1000 after all financial assistance is applied for each semester.
