Planning to Transfer?

Ozarka offers general education courses through the Associates of Arts program that transfer to most colleges and universities around the State of Arkansas. The Associate of Arts in Teaching will prepare students to continue an education in pursuit of Pre-4th grade or middle school teaching.

Affordable

Over 70% of our students receive some type of financial aid.

Grants - These are funds that do not have to be repaid. There are Federal and State grants available to students based on income and need. The most common grant available is the Federal Pell Grant.



Scholarships - Many scholarships are available to students based on academics, talent or skill, financial need, or a major area of study. The Ozarka scholarship application is located under financial aid at www.ozarka.edu. Arkansas Lottery Scholarships are available to qualifying students. Apply online by June 1st at www.adhe.edu.

Federal Work Study - Funds are available to employ students part-time on campus or at some off-campus, non-profit agencies. These jobs provide an hour's pay for an hour's work.

Student Loans - Students may apply for loans through federal agencies or financial institutions. This money has to be repaid upon completing the education process.

A Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be completed each year to determine a student's financial need as well as aid eligibility. These can be filed online www.FAFSA.Ed.Gov.

- Apply online at www.ozarka.edu.
- Submit official high school transcript or GED transcript of score report.
- Provide proof of immunizations against measles, mumps, and rubella.
- Supply official ACT, Asset, or Compass test scores.
- Provide acceptable photo identification (must submit in person).
